2019 TERO Estates Rosé of Charbono

Glowing with a wonderful peach color, this delicate and well balanced wine entices your senses with a bouquet of fresh spring flowers, strawberry, pomegranate and raspberry jam. Tasting this beautiful Rosé leaves nothing to be desired. Citrus notes of lemon zest and orange marmalade mingle with red raspberries bringing a delightful brightness to the soft and smooth mouthfeel which is sure to leave you with a warm smile. This Rosé is perfect for any occasion with or without food.

2015 TERO Estates ST

This 56% Sangiovese, 44% Cabernet Sauvignon combination exhibits a semi-opaque ruby-garnet color and a seductive nose of wild raspberries, black cherries, plums, rose petals, sweet tobacco, mulberry, orange peel, sandalwood and incense. The flavors, as well, are dramatic, with layers of thick black and red fruits that are infused with licorice, dark cocoa, French roast and silty minerals. The penetration continues on the back with roasted berries and chestnuts, mocha, ground charcoal and burnt toast, followed by a lingering dryish moderate tannin finish that evokes a "Super Tuscan" red.~Rand Sealey

2015 TERO Estates DC3

Rich ruby in color, this distinctive blend from our estate vineyard has aromas of freshly baked blackberry pie, cherry, chocolate, violets and vanilla with earthy counterparts of leather, tobacco, lush herbs, grasses and white pepper. This is a full-bodied wine with flavors of briny minerals, leather, cedar, pepper and pipe tobacco balanced by dried Rainier cherry, licorice, cassis, spiced punch, cinnamon, figs and dark chocolate. The intoxicating blend of flavors will make you fall in love with life all over again and speaks to climate, culture and place. Pair with grilled Tri-Tip or French pork roast while watching the sunset.

2016 TERO Estates Petit Verdot

This rich, dark and inky wine begins with aromatic notes of Bing cherry and star anise that entice the senses while warm hints of roasted red pepper and sun-dried tomato draw you in for more. Dark flavors of black currants and Damson plums frolic on the palate opening up to notes of pink pepper corn, cranberry, and pomegranate. This fullbodied wine leaves nothing to be desired. Best paired with good friends and a leg of lamb with roasted root vegetables.

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2013 TERO Estates Windrow Field Blend

70% Cabernet Sauvignon, 14% Merlot, 10% Cabernet Franc, 6% Malbec. The warm weather of the 2013 vintage brought about new and exciting things in this vintage of Windrow. A gorgeous deep ruby color, one almost wants to sit all day and just breathe in the aromas of stewed black cherries, sweet tobacco, and a tiny bit of balsam fir. But drink it you must because it is even better on the palate! Black cherry, ripe plums, and a hint of toast and cedar are prominent and long-lasting with a silky smooth and satisfying finish. Another incredible wine from TERO Estates.

2014 TERO Estates Plateau Block Cabernet Sauvignon

Full-bodied and powerfully fragrant, this stunner opens up with red currants and rhubarb chutney which gives way to a bouquet of hibiscus blossoms, violets, and Rainier cherries while a delicate minerality enlivens the senses. On the palate, black currants, dark cherries and baking spices are enriched by a hint of hickory smoke and an incredible mouth feel. Plateau Block is always alluring, aromatic, and full of character and this vintage is no different. Best paired with a glass!

2014 TERO Estates Hill Block Cabernet Sauvignon

This wine opens with aromas of sweet fig, brandied cherries, plum, blackberries, strawberry jam and shows off with undertones of smoke and wet stone. An absolutely decadent palate of dates, black cherries, currants, brownies and strawberries are accompanied by hearty flavors of smoked meats, black pepper, licorice spice, and earthy leather and tobacco tones. This robust wine begs for a leisurely dinner on the deck watching the sunset. Pair this beauty with slow roasted beef brisket, pork chops slathered in sundried tomato pesto, or wild mushroom lasagna with goat cheese.

2014 TERO Estates Old Block Cabernet Sauvignon

2014 was an ideal growing year and the accolades we have received for our other 2014 wines reflect that sentiment. The Old Block Cabernet Sauvignon is no different. This is a great expression of Windrow Vineyards 39 year old cabernet vines, showing dark fruit through the smoky earthiness with a full mouthfeel and a long finish.~Doug Roskelley, Winemaker

2012 TERO Estates Nebbiolo

2014 TERO Estates Charbono

The Charbono is a fabulous food-friendly wine and like our S.T. goes with almost anything. It is a big, round red with great color and bright acidity. Charbono comes from the Savoie region of France and you know how much Doug loves his French wines!

2014 TERO Estates Petit(e)2

A blend of 62% Petite Sirah and 38% Petit Verdot, the deep ruby-purple colored wine is scented of black licorice, baked black cherries and blackberry jam with accents of cloves, powdered cinnamon and Ibérico ham. Full-bodied and a behemoth in the mouth, it's packed full of warm, ripe, lush black fruits with accents of blueberry jam, bacon fat and exotic flowers, lifted by just enough freshness and finishing very long.
